

Vision: *Whereas the business of vegetation management practices are critical with regards to the environment, health and public perception, the IVMAA believes that companies following the IVMAA Registries Code of Conduct should be recognized.*

Purpose: *To outline a fee structure and describe what is covered by the fee for companies who have registered in the voluntary IVMAA Registries program.*

Fee Structure Description

Company Registration: A one-time registration fee of \$100 will include:

- Registration in the IVMAA Registries program
- Covers development costs of the program
- Costs incurred education industry
- Aiding in the IVMAA branding initiatives
- A number unique to your company
- Enough decals to place (2) on each of your working units
- Includes one version of the IVMAA Standards and Good practices manual.
- Once the company has paid this fee only the annual unit fee applies.

Unit Fees: Each working unit will be charged an annual fee of \$25.

- Each year a set of annual registration stickers for each working unit registered
- The fee will cover administration costs
- Administration of the reporting telephone line and costs
